1. Incidents: In April we were toned out for mutual aid to support technical rescue. Four members of the CPVFD High Angle Rescue Team responded to Rainbow Falls in Manitou to execute a technical rescue of a fall victim. Following the incident, Chief Buckmiller (MSFD) requested from Chief Hennessey (CPVFD) that for any technical rescue call, CPVFD HAR be automatically dispatched. This is in addition to CPVFD automatically toned when there is a structure fire in Manitou. CPVFD volunteers continued to support numerous other calls in Manitou Springs this last month to help maintain our proficiency as a **Fire**•Rescue•EMS organization.

5. New Water Tender Acquisition: Metro District and CPVFD have been working on an acquisition of a second water tender. The deal is not complete until approved by the Metro District but the tender meets the requirements we laid out for this procurement.
