 - c) Additions were \$2,286.00
 - d) Deductions totaled \$19,818.13
 - e) The General Fund (available) balance is \$120,973.05
- 2) Tabor Emergency Fund Stands at \$1,371.07

- 2) The Fire Department has formed a committee to work on obtaining a new/used tender. The committee has produced a list of requirements that would be a priority for a tender that can perform under the conditions of Crystal Park.

They are still hoping to purchase a tender from Manitou Springs Fire Department (MSFD).

3) MSFD is preparing to begin the changes to their department beginning February 1st. They will continue to service Crystal Park with AMR as a backup.

- d.) Resolution to Adopt Budget. A Resolution Summarizing Expenditures and Revenues for each fund and adopting a budget for the Crystal Park Metropolitan District, Colorado for the calendar year beginning on the first day of January 2023 and ending on the last day of December 2023.

Marlene Henderson moved to approve the four above resolutions and Micky Salsgiver seconded the motion. The Resolutions were adopted.

- 3) <u>Update on Bathroom</u>: Jim Terbush has set up an account with Home Depot and has ordered some items which were in the 2022 Budget.
- 3) <u>Fire Protection Codes:</u> Chief Leander has been working with Paul Welsch to complete the Crystal Park Fire Protection Codes. Crystal Park will be adopting the codes based on the Colorado Springs fire codes which are the El Paso County fire codes. Crystal Park HOA will continue to not allow outdoor fire pits when the community is under Stage One restrictions.
- 4) <u>Update on the Lake Pump Project</u> Eric Jenkins reported that the pump is here and ready to be installed.

New Business

1) <u>Recruitment for New CPMD Board Members:</u> It was suggested that recruiting new board members for CPMD should be a priority for the new year and a special search for a treasurer.
